Session II: 1pm-4pm - *Infield & Outfield* develop solid fundamentals with glove work, footwork, throwing, and receiving a ball; Additionally we will teach baserunning technique and strategy to develop well-rounded players

Session III: 9am-12pm - *Pitching Fundamentals* taught following biomechanical principles to use the body's natural levers to get the most from your frame. Catching Fundamentals of receiving, blocking, throwing, and philosophies on calling a game.

Session IV: 1pm-4pm *High School Prospect Camp* for athletes seeking college exposure and introduction to the recruiting process.
